Here is an excerpt from our young Burundian co-laborers, Philemon and John Peter. (I chose not to correct their English in this message they sent me so I could keep their message unchanged)
“Our main focus of these 4 last months has been to respond to the basic needs of the kids such as food, education, health. But in order to be effective in our Call of serving, we bought a small land in the middle of the community in which we built a small house where every child is held and welcomed especially the Orphans. This home is call **“Temporary orphanage”** because we believe God he will make a way for us to build them a residential home. Glory be to God we not longer working in the street.

Since 5th nov 2016 today, more one hundred of kids From the community benefits porridge 3day a week. This food program has been helpful for the well-being of the kids. Now the malnutrition diseases are not reccurent as it was before the beginning of this program

Concerning education, we now have a tent where every under seven child should come to enjoy Education for 5 hours per day . This preschool program has urgently initiated in the Line of enchancing many Twa kids to enjoy education in their earlier age. We have 3 teachers that volunteer with us. They are such amazing girls with the servent hood heart. Imagine they spend 5 hours training and teaching the kids without expecting salary at the end of the month. We believe that education is a key Element to every sustainable development.

For the health care of the kids we supply clean water to all kids that go to school especially those under seven year old. We took this decision of buying them water after realising that most of the disease that currenty attack the kids are caused by unclear water consumed, We also buy medecine to the kids especially for the orphans”

I ask for your prayers as I prepare to go to the TWA village on Apri 3rd. We hope to secure a parcel of land that would be the permanent location for the TWA orphan ministry. We will be meeting and seeking advice from other Burundi leaders that are involved in reaching the orphans in their country.
